

Report: AROMA 2020, an online Inter-School Language Fest hosted by Delhi Police Public School.

At the online Inter-School Language Fest titled *Aroma 2020-VIBGYOR*, hosted by Delhi Police Public School, Anahita Johar of IX A bagged the second prize at the contest named *Talking Titans*.

For this online contest the participants had to recite the speech of not more than two minutes of a renowned leader and send it in the form of an MP4 file. The participant could either pick an extract from the speech or choose the most relevant and poignant lines to form a cohesive whole. However, the original speech was not to be altered. Participants were allowed to be creative in their ensemble, in order to resemble or remind the audience of the leader they had chosen. All entries were to be sent across to the host school by the 20th of May 2020, and the results were declared on the host school's website on the 27th of May 2020.

Anahita recited an excerpt from Malala Yousafzai's speech that she delivered at the UN Youth Takeover, on July 12, 2013. Malala Yousafzai's speech was a tribute to all those who fought for their rights-the right to live in peace, to be treated with dignity, to equal opportunity, and to be educated.

Anahita recited this speech with commendable expression and fluency, and clear diction and pronunciation. She used a light prop in the form of a pink headscarf to remind the audience of the personality she was quoting. The recitation of this speech was a clear indication of the dedicated and diligent efforts that Anahita had put in to prepare for the competition.
